How it works:

This is achieved by constantly cycling between all guns available

What are fixed exclusion zones?

- These are areas on a farm where effluent cannot be applied from a sprinkler. These may be tracks, troughs, wet areas or anywhere you do not want effluent applied.
- Each zone has programmable start and stop degree points. There can be multiple zones programmed to one gun throughout the pivots range of operation.
- The same exclusion zones can be applied to multiple guns on the pivot at once.


